**1 Peter 1:22-25** Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for your brothers (**SPOUSE**), **love one another deeply, from the heart.** 23 For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God. 24 For, "All men are like grass, and all their glory is like the **flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall,** 25 but the word of the Lord stands forever." And this is the word that was preached to you.

**Psalm 39:4-6** Show me, O Lord, my life's end and the number of my days; **let me know how fleeting is my life.** You have made my **days a mere handbreadth; the span of my years is as nothing before you.** **Each man's life is but a breath. Man is a mere phantom as he goes to and fro...**

**Phil 4:8** Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable — if anything is excellent or praiseworthy — think about such things.
